NOTES

1. The Baseball NL representative will be appointed by Metro Director Kristyn Coley. The Umpire Supervisor will be appointed by Umpire-In-Chief Mark Jones
2. Games will be scheduled for Monday, September 4th if necessary due to rain
3. Home team for all round robin games will be decided by the underlined team on the schedule.
4. Pitchers will be using pitch count. Pitch count rules and regulations can be found in the 2023 Baseball NL Handbook, which is downloadable from the Baseball NL website.
5. Please consult the 2023 Baseball NL Handbook for all tournament regulations. The handbook can be downloaded from the Baseball NL website.
6. The tournament format will have each team play four games, random draw round robin with the top three teams advancing to the playoffs. The #1 seed will receive a bye to the Championship game, with 2nd and 3rd place playing in the Semifinal and the winner advancing to the Championship game. In the event of a tie in the standings after round robin play, the Baseball NL tie-breaking system will be used. **There are no tiebreaker games of any kind.**

NOTE: Least number of runs allowed per defensive inning is calculated by taking the total number of runs allowed and dividing it by the total number of defensive innings played, including any partial innings played.

NOTE: In a game where a team wins by mercy rule, the winning team will be credited with seven (7) defensive innings played, while the losing team will only be credited with the number of defensive innings they played.
