2. Games will be scheduled for Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup> if necessary due to rain
3. Home team for all round robin games will be decided by the underlined team on the schedule.
4. Pitchers will be using pitch count. Pitch count rules and regulations can be found in the 2023 Baseball NL Handbook, which is downloadable from the Baseball NL website.
5. Please consult the 2023 Baseball NL Handbook for all tournament regulations. The handbook can be downloaded from the Baseball NL website.
6. The tournament format will have a single round robin tournament with the top two teams advancing to the Championship Game. In the event of a tie in the standings after the round robin, ties will be broken using Baseball NL tie-breaking system. Below are the tiebreaking scenarios:

2	Team A: 4 – 0 Team B: 2 – 2 Team C: 2 – 2 Team D: 2 – 2	The 2 – 2 team with the least number of runs in games among the tied teams only will advance to a <b>SINGLE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME</b>
3	Team A: 3 – 1 Team B: 3 – 1	<b>SINGLE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME</b> where the winner of the round robin game is the home team
4	Team A: 3 – 1 Team B: 2 – 2 Team C: 2 – 2 Team D: 2 – 2	The 2 – 2 team with the least number of runs in games among the tied teams only will advance to a <b>SINGLE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME</b>
5	Team A: 4 – 0 Team B: 2 – 2 Team C: 2 – 2	The winner of the round robin game between the 2 – 2 teams advances to a <b>SINGLE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME</b>
6	Team A: 3 – 1 Team B: 3 – 1 Team C: 3 – 1	The team with the least runs per defensive inning in games among the tied teams only will receive a bye to the final. The remaining two teams will play a tiebreaker game to determine the second finalist.
7	Team A: 2 – 2 Team B: 2 – 2 Team C: 2 – 2 Team D: 2 – 2 Team E: 2 – 2	The team with the least runs per defensive inning in games among the tied teams only will receive a bye to the final. The next best two teams will play a tiebreaker game to determine the second finalist
