UMPIRE CLINIC INFORMATION – 2023

Baseball NL is pleased to announce its umpire clinic information for the 2023 season. Once again, Baseball NL will be partnering with Baseball Ontario to offer self-driven virtual classroom content before hosting on-field practical sessions later this spring.

Online Virtual Classroom Registration

New for 2023 – participants can now register directly with Baseball Ontario via their OnDeck virtual system. In order to register:

1. Head to the [Baseball Ontario OnDeck](#) virtual registration system and create your account
 - a. *For anyone that has used Baseball Ontario's online system since the 2020 season, this is a NEW SYSTEM and all users MUST create a new account. Accounts from previous years DO NOT transfer to this new system.*
2. When completing your profile, indicate which level of umpire you are in the "What is your primary role with Baseball Ontario?" section. Options pertinent for umpire clinics:
 - a. Level 1.1 (new umpires – first year)
 - b. Level 1.2 (2nd year umpires)
 - c. Level 2.1 (3rd year umpires – first year Level II)
 - d. Level 2.2 (4th year umpires – second year Level II)
 - e. Level 2.3 (5th year umpires – third year Level II)
 - f. Level 3 (more than five years)
3. Once you have set up your profile, click on your name in the top right corner, then click "my account", then choose "certifications" from the left menu, then choose the corresponding certification from Available Certifications.

As this is self-driven and self-paced material, participants are expected to have the online content completed prior to the in-person practical session for their region.

In-Person Practical On-Field Sessions

Upon completion of the online content, participants will be expected to participate in an in-person practical session to complete their full certification for the 2023 season.

Practical sessions for Eastern umpires will take place **May 19 – 21 weekend** in St. John's. Exact times and details will be communicated in the coming weeks.

Practical sessions for Central and Western umpires will be held in conjunction with facilitators in each region once availability is confirmed and registration numbers are known. More information will be sent out in the coming weeks.
