



# BASEBALL NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR

## ANNUAL AWARD NOMINATIONS

Baseball Newfoundland and Labrador is now accepting nominations for its Annual Awards, honoring its best coaches, officials, players, teams and volunteers for their performances and/or contributions to the sport of baseball. We invite all members to nominate those individuals who deserve recognition for their performance over the past year.

The Executive reviews the applications and selects the most deserving nominee in each category. There is no limit on the number of times an individual can be nominated. The more information the committee receives, the better they can assess your nominee. Nominations should be between 250 and 500 words and include specific references to stats, awards, and records. Nominations must also include a picture (of good quality) of the nominee that can be used during the Annual Awards Reception. Nominations should only reference competition at Baseball NL sanctioned or affiliated events (local invitational tournaments, Provincials, Atlantic, Nationals, Baseball Canada training camps, etc).

### Awards

#### **1. Minor Male Player of the Year**

- Nominations are open to players who participated in 13U and under in the previous season.
- If players participated in multiple divisions, they will only be considered in their primary division based on age.
- Nominees are considered based on possessing a strong dedication to baseball, attitudes, developmental progress, cooperation, and sportsmanship.
- While possessing an outstanding playing record, the player must show team leadership, enhancing the image of baseball philosophies

#### **2. Minor Female Player of the Year**

- Nominations are open to players who participated in 14U and under in the previous season.
- If players participated in multiple divisions, they will only be considered in their primary division based on age.
- Nominees are considered based on possessing a strong dedication to baseball, attitudes, developmental progress, cooperation, and sportsmanship.
- While possessing an outstanding playing record, the player must show team leadership, enhancing the image of baseball philosophies

#### **3. Major Male Player of the Year**

- Nominations are open to players who participated in 15U and 18U divisions in the previous season. Players who fit in this age categories based on age but participated in other divisions (Junior, Senior, etc) would need to be nominated under this category.
- Nominees are considered based on possessing a strong dedication to baseball, attitudes, developmental progress, cooperation, and sportsmanship.
- While possessing an outstanding playing record, the player must show team leadership,

enhancing the image of baseball philosophies.

**4. Major Female Player of the Year**

- Nominations are open to players who participated in 16U and older in the previous season.
- If players participated in multiple divisions, they will only be considered in their primary division based on age.
- Nominees are considered based on possessing a strong dedication to baseball, attitudes, developmental progress, cooperation, and sportsmanship.
- While possessing an outstanding playing record, the player must show team leadership, enhancing the image of baseball philosophies

**5. Sr/Jr Player of the Year**

- Nominations are open to players of any gender over the age of 18 who participated in Junior and/or Senior local league and/or Provincial competition in the previous season.
- Nominees are considered based on possessing a strong dedication to baseball, attitudes, developmental progress, cooperation, and sportsmanship.
- While possessing an outstanding playing record, the player must show team leadership, enhancing the image of baseball philosophies

**6. High Performance Coach of the Year**

- Nominations are open to coaches who coached AAA teams, 18U AA, provincial teams, senior teams or junior teams.
- If coaches participated in high performance and grassroots divisions, they can be nominated in multiple divisions but only the stats relevant to the award they are being nominated for will be considered.
- The nominees must display managerial objectives of motivation, inspiration, direction, and leadership.
- Recognition is based on the ability to enhance the value of the game as a team sport, develop young players, and community respect.

**7. Grassroots Coach of the Year**

- Nominations are open to coaches who coached AA teams, A teams or house league teams.
- If coaches participated in high performance and grassroots divisions, they can be nominated in multiple divisions but only the stats relevant to the award they are being nominated for will be considered.
- The nominees must display managerial objectives of motivation, inspiration, direction, and leadership.
- Recognition is based on the ability to enhance the value of the game as a team sport, develop young players, and community respect.
- Efforts are recognized for establishing baseball in the community

**8. Female Coach of the Year**

- Nominations are open to all female coaches in any category
- The nominees must display managerial objectives of motivation, inspiration, direction, and leadership.
- Recognition is based on the ability to enhance the value of the game as a team sport, develop young players, and community respect.
- Efforts are recognized for establishing baseball in the community.

**9. Minor Umpire of the Year**

- Nominations open for any registered umpire who is under 18 years old and who through the year has performed in an outstanding manner.
- Nominations should include a brief overview of games umpired, including the level(s) in which the individual umpired. Nominations should also include a record of any key assignments and/or important games.
- If applicable, nominations can include an assessment of umpire's progress/development throughout the year

**10. Major Umpire of the Year**

- Nominations open for any registered umpire who is 18 years old and older, who through the year has performed in an outstanding manner.
- Nominations should include a brief overview of games umpired, including the level(s) in which the individual umpired. Nominations should also include a record of any key assignments and/or important games.
- If applicable, nominations can include an assessment of umpire's progress/development throughout the year

**11. High Performance Team of the Year**

- Nominations are open to AAA teams, 18U AA, provincial teams, senior teams or junior teams.
- Teams must have excelled in performance during the year. The team's record of competing in and winning championships shall be the main principle in accepting nominees in this category.
- The level of competition (provincials, Atlantics or Nationals) that a team has faced will be integral in determining this award.
- Team conduct, deportment, and behavior while engaging in their games must be considered top priority in the interests of enhancing the image of baseball.

**12. Grassroots Team of the Year**

- Nominations are open to AA teams, A teams or house league teams.
- Teams must have excelled in performance during the year. The team's record of competing in and winning championships shall be the main principle in accepting nominees in this category.
- The level of competition (Provincials, Atlantics or Nationals) that a team has faced will be integral in determining this award.
- Team conduct, deportment, and behavior while engaging in their games must be

considered top priority in the interests of enhancing the image of baseball.

### **13. Les Noseworthy Award**

- This award honours an individual who has made a significant contribution to the growth and development of baseball in Newfoundland and Labrador
- Nominations are open to an individual who has distinguished themselves in an outstanding manner and must include volunteer activities or initiatives.
- While this is a yearly award and preference will be given to active members, a complete record of achievements must accompany any nomination
